Summary	The Colorado Fuel & Iron Company in Pueblo, Colorado, was created in 1892 to produce iron and steel for use in continuing the narrow gauge Denver & Rio Grande Railway from Pueblo to Canon City. Two buildings with large smokestacks are in the left background, possibly at the Minnequa Works. Several standard gauge box cars of the Colorado Midland and the Union Pacific Denver & Gulf railroads are in the midground in front of the buildings. Several private box cars are in the view, including one from the C.R. Havens & Company wholesale coal manufacturer in Omaha, Nebraska.
