Join the United States Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) and our partners for a community meeting!

The purpose of the availability session is for community members to meet and engage with the EPA site team and other partners to discuss next steps for the Fairmont Brine Processing site. Please arrive at least 15 minutes prior to start time to be escorted into the building.

EPA is coordinating with the WV Department of Health (WV DH), WV Department of Environmental Protection (WV DEP), and Marion County Department of Homeland Security and Emergency Services to address the presence of Technologically Enhanced Naturally Occurring Radioactive Material (TENORM) at the Fairmont Brine facility. An Action Memorandum was issued for the site. The Action Memorandum describes the site's history, health and environmental threats, and the cleanup actions EPA will take at the site. EPA and our partners welcome those interested in the Fairmont Brine Site to join us and discuss progress and upcoming plans for the Site.
