Current Activities

CRA completed a free product investigation on behalf of the respondent group that included:

- 1. On site and off-site subsurface laser-induced flourescence (LIF) coupled with soil borings to confirm LIF screening/responses and define the extent of free product.
- 2. Installation of two 4-inch diameter monitoring wells in areas previously identified free product areas.
- 3. A free product bail-down test.
- 4. Periodic free product monitoring.

On April 14, 2010, CRA submitted a revised Site Investigation Report on behalf of the respondent group that summarizes all removal and investigation actions performed to date; and evaluation of additional removal options.
